# REGISTRATION FEES/INVOICE FORM DIRECTIONS:

- ❖ A fee of \$385.00 per student includes meals, housing, music and all festival expenses.
- **Checks** (NO purchase orders) are to be made payable to: **PMEA**.
- ❖ The Registration Fee may also be paid with a credit card (all major credit cards accepted) however a convenience fee of \$10.00 per student will be incurred. You will still need to mail the completed Invoice Form for EACH participating student to the PMEA Office.
- ❖ A mailing envelope to PMEA (56 S. Third St. Hamburg, PA 19526) is included in the student folder. A completed Invoice Form should accompany the check. If there are multiple student registrations covered by one check, a completed invoice for EACH student to be covered by the payment must be included with the mailing.
- \* \*\*CHECKS and completed invoices going to the PMEA office may ALL be mailed together at the conclusion of the LAST REGION FESTIVAL (BAND) in order to include ALL students from your school attending the All-State Festival\*\*

- \* \*\*Completed School Acknowledgement forms (ENSEMBLE SPECIFIC) may ALL be mailed together to P.O. Box 1309 Meadville, PA 16335 (or emailed to allstate@pmea.net) at the conclusion of the LAST REGION FESTIVAL (BAND) in order to include ALL students from your school attending the All-State Festival\*\* Would also need to include the Director(s) who will be accompanying student(s) to Festival.

# MEDICAL ADMINISTRATION RECORD FORMS:

- ♦ If your child needs to be given medication during the PMEA Festival, a separate Medication Administration Record form for each medication to be administered must be completed including Licensed Prescriber's Signature. The Med. Admin. Form may be downloaded by going to the PMEA Website- <a href="www.pmea.net">www.pmea.net</a>, Scroll to "Conferences and Events" and click on "PMEA All-State Information".
- PMEA will accept a copy of the Medical Administration Form on file with your school district for medications taken during the school day including Action Plans (as long as consent has been given for the form to be used).
- A separate Medical Administration Form for EACH medication, including over the counter medications may need to be completed for medications which are not on file at the school and

- are normally dispensed at home, especially morning and evening medications. See above information to download Medical Administration record Form.
- Medications in their original package AND the completed Medical Administration Form for each including "over the counter medications" such as Ibuprofen, Antacids, etc. must be placed in a Ziploc baggie with the student's full name and ensemble marked in Sharpie. Nurses will be on site to collect and review medication orders at the Instrumental Audition site-(Concert Band, Wind Ensemble, Orchestra), Rehearsal site-(Jazz and Vocal Jazz) and Chorus Announcement Site.

- ALL Students will be housed at the Kalahari Resort & Conference Center 250 Kalahari Blvd. Pocono Manor, PA 18349.
- There will be NO Luggage trucks at the Instrumental audition site OR the Jazz/ Vocal Jazz Rehearsal site due to the close proximity of the schools to the Kalahari Resort.

- Directors are to transport their students and music instruments/equipment to the rehearsal site. (NO Bus from Kalahari). Directors of these participating students are exempt from further auditions!
- ❖ 5:30 pm- Meeting with Host Mr. Jeff Mark and Jazz/Vocal Jazz Chaperones in Auditorium, introduction of Guest Conductors and downbeat is at 6:00 pm.
- ❖ INSTRUMENTAL (BAND, WIND ENSEMBLE, ORCHESTRA) AUDITION REGISTRATION TIMES-3:45 pm - 5:45 pm AT Pocono Mountain East HS 231 Pocono Mountain School Road Swiftwater, PA 18370. (Mr. Tim Eick- Host Director) Directors are responsible for student transportation to the Audition site. (NO luggage truck is available)
- ❖ 6:00 pm Directors report to assigned rooms to choose audition excerpts. Also, meeting with tabs, runners, sgt at arms, and holding room monitors with Instrumental Auditions to follow. (Fran Nesta, PMEA All-State Audition Coordinator).
- ❖ CHORAL REGISTRATION- 4:00 pm- 6:00 pm in the designated room at the Kalahari Resort & Conference Center. Students will receive information at Hotel Check-In.
- ♦ 6:30 pm- Meeting with Host Ms. Katye Clogg, Chorus Chaperones and Nurses in Main Designated Room at Kalahari. (Roll will be taken).
- Rules and AUDITION results will be read at this time. At conclusion of Meeting, CHORUS students have options for the evening including- swimming, arcade, board games, etc. but must stay in the Main Building. 9:00 pm- students are to report back to Main designated room- roll will be taken and students will be escorted by their Chaperones back to their hotel rooms.
